“I Am Getting to Know God” Session Two: When Bad Things Happen



Life Plus Discipleship Classes (Part 2)

Join us for a great time in the study of God’s Word as we seek to grow as followers of Jesus Christ. This discipleship emphasis began January 15 and will conclude April 1 from 6:00-7:15 p.m. in lieu of our Sunday evening worship service. Nursery will be provided for

birth through 4 years old. Our children will participate in Kids 411 and the youth will participate in their regular time of Bible study. The studies for **adults** are listed below for your consideration.

Payment for member books (adult classes ONLY) will be received the first night of class. **Please Note:** You are not required to purchase a member book to participate in any class. Utilizing the member book will help you to gain the most from the study.

The Following 12 Session Classes began on January 15 and will be continuing through April 1. You are welcome to join these classes!!!:

What In The World Is Going On? is a study by Dr. David Jeremiah that presents ten scriptural prophecies in a chronological checklist and explains how current events fit into the biblical framework for the end times. Pastor Mark Ball will facilitate this study. The cost of the member book is \$8. (12 Sessions)

A Study of the Book of Ecclesiastes will be taught by Rex Williams and is based in part on the 2012 January Bible Study “The Pursuit: Chasing Answers to Life’s Questions”. Ecclesiastes may well be the most contemporary book in the Bible, speaking to the very people who are most likely to build their lives on success, wealth, power, and intellectual reputation. Ecclesiastes points out the futility of such a way of life, urging instead that people face their need for God. The cost of the member book is \$7 (12 Sessions).

The following 6 Session Classes will be offered February 26 through April 1:

R12 by Chip Ingram is a study of Romans Chapter 12 that will help you to examine what it means to live for Jesus Christ in a genuine way. Mary Thompson will facilitate the study. No Book. No cost. (6 Sessions)

Confident Parenting is a study by Jim Burns, an award winning author and founder of HomeWord. He has a great passion for equipping families to live for Christ. Jim Burns offers time-tested advice and strategies for today’s families. Infused with his signature candidness and practicality, this study explores the different aspects of parenting from breaking generational chains of dysfunction and creating a warm atmosphere at home to handling discipline issues and blessing your children with a legacy of faith. Pastor Andy Anderson will facilitate this study. Cost of the member book is \$10. *(This class is for parents of children from birth through youth.)*

(For Men) Honor Begins at Home: The Courageous Bible Study – this compelling Bible study is based on the movie “Courageous”. This 8-session study will take participants deeper into biblical truths for a godly family, exploring topics such as redeeming your history, walking with integrity, winning and blessing the hearts of your children, and more. Each session involves watching a clip from the movie “Courageous” to help group members engage in discussion and utilizing the member book and the readings from The Resolution for Men. Dale Riley will facilitate this study. (8 Sessions – the group will determine a schedule for two additional meetings between February 26 and April 1 to complete the study.) Member Book \$8, Resolution for Men Book \$10.
