Baby Bottle Boomerang

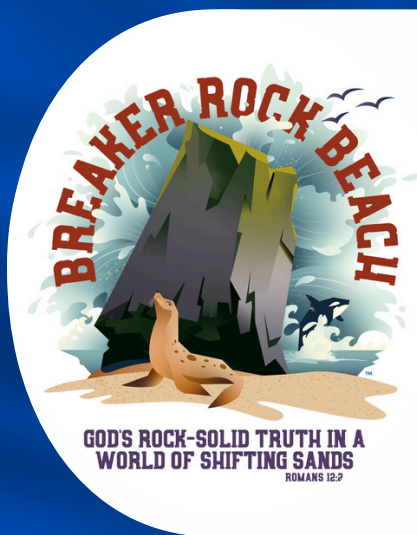

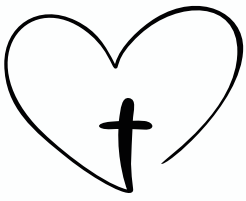
Youth Fort Caswell Summer Camp

Every May we make room in our worship service to honor people in our congregation. This May, we honor our seniors on the first Sunday, mothers the second, graduates the third, and last we remember those who have died in the previous year. I say we make room because honoring people is an appropriate way to worship the Lord. By recognizing our members we glimpse the Lord at work in their lives, and respond in appropriate praise. It's still worship.

My sermon series this month is the book of Esther. In the book you will not find God mentioned by name. The people of God show very little commitment to God's law. The deliverance is brought about by a pagan king's decree. It's all about people. But because Esther is included in the Bible we can see the events and persons in it as fulfilling the plan of God. "The true test is living for Christ at this present moment, in the place where one happens to be, in whatever situation one finds herself or himself." I pray you have an opportunity to see how the Lord has worked in the lives of our people this May, and give Him glory for it.
