PURPOSE:

To provide uniform guidelines in the scholarship recipient selection process.

REFERENCES:

Scholarship Committee, Each prospective applicant.

POLICY:

- I. Applicants
 - A. Must be a member of Southside Baptist Church.
 - B. Must be a graduating high school senior seeking training beyond the high school level.
 - C. The application must be completed and received by the church by the first Sunday in April.
 - D. A copy of these guidelines will be provided to each applicant.

- II. Recipient
 - A. Shall have a definite need for financial assistance.
 - B. Shall have met entrance requirements and be accepted by a post-secondary institution. (college, university, technical school, or community college).

- III. Grants
 - A. Shall be awarded on a one-year basis.
 - B. May be awarded to one eligible recipient in an amount not to exceed \$500.
 - C. Grant will be paid to the school of choice, not the recipient.
 - D. The selected recipient will be announced during the annual Graduate Recognition Service.

E. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to make no grant in any one year should there be no applicant who, in the opinion of the committee, qualifies according to all the requirements of this policy.

PROCEDURE:

1. Beginning in January, publicize the Scholarship Grant.
2. Make copies of the "Scholarship Application" (Attachment 1) available in the church office.
3. All applications must be completed and received by the church by the first Sunday in April.
4. The committee accepts applications, noting the date.
5. The committee meets in April to receive applications.
6. Interview the qualified applicants using the "Scholarship Interviewer's Questions" (Attachment 2)
7. Rate each applicant using the "Committee Rating Notes" (Attachment 3).
8. Make arrangements for an engraved plaque to be made and placed on the plaque board in the hallway.
9. Have the Church Secretary make a certificate honoring the recipient.
10. Have a Scholarship Committee member present the certificate to the recipient on Graduation Recognition Sunday. A sample presentation (Attachment 4).
11. Insert all completed forms into the Scholarship book, kept in the church office.
12. Update recipient information in the Scholarship book.
